CoDIT 2025 will be held July 15-18, 2025 at Split, Croatia.

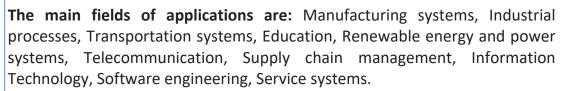
